

Wah Yan (HK) PSA and MSSAA Joint School Mentorship Program 2011 – “Leader born-to-be ?!”

9th April, 2011 marked the success of another joint school mentorship program organized by Wah Yan (Hong Kong) Past Students Association (WYHKPSA) and Marymount Secondary School Alumnae Association (MSSAA). This year, the program was held in the school hall of MSS. With the theme “Leader born-to-be ?!”, we aimed at arousing interests from the audience particularly mentees in preparing themselves to be future leaders. In addition, the program also provided a platform for alumnae from both schools to share their experience in their respective career fields and strengthen the bonding with the mentees both within as well as across our schools.
